- Format your manuscript to meet Amazon's Kindle Direct Publishing (KDP) guidelines
- Use included templates to apply correct spacing, headings, and layout
- Create a book cover using free tools like Canva or by outsourcing through provided resources

Uploading and Publishing

- Register a free KDP account
- Upload your book and enter metadata: title, description, keywords, categories, and pricing
- Submit for review and go live in Amazon's global bookstore

- Track your royalty earnings through the KDP dashboard
