What You'll Be Creating

The focus is on short, highly usable Kindle products that don't require creativity or marketing. You'll follow a checklist-style workflow to create content formats such as:

- · Niche-specific journals and logs
- Goal-setting and productivity planners
- · Basic instructional guides for everyday topics
- · Wellness and financial tracking tools
- Reference-style mini-books with structured outlines

Templates are provided for every content type, so you never have to start with a blank page.

How the Process Works

This program walks you through the full publishing workflow, from choosing a topic to getting your product live on Kindle. Each task is clearly explained, and every project is broken down into manageable chunks.

Your publishing week might look like this:

- Day 1: Pick a niche from the provided list and review its template
- Day 2–3: Complete the content using structured writing prompts
- Day 4: Finalize and format using the Kindle preparation checklist
- Day 5: Upload to Kindle and go live
- Days 6-7: Begin planning your next release
